Project overview and benefits

Project overview



Expand express toll lane (ETL) capacity.



Widen I-405 through the SR 522 interchange.



Add direct access ramps at the SR 527 and SR 522.



Construct a new transit hub, build inline Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) stations on I-405, and improve bus transit connections locally.



Improve connections for pedestrians and cyclists to transit and trails.



Improve local roadways and state routes.



Correct and repair fish barriers.

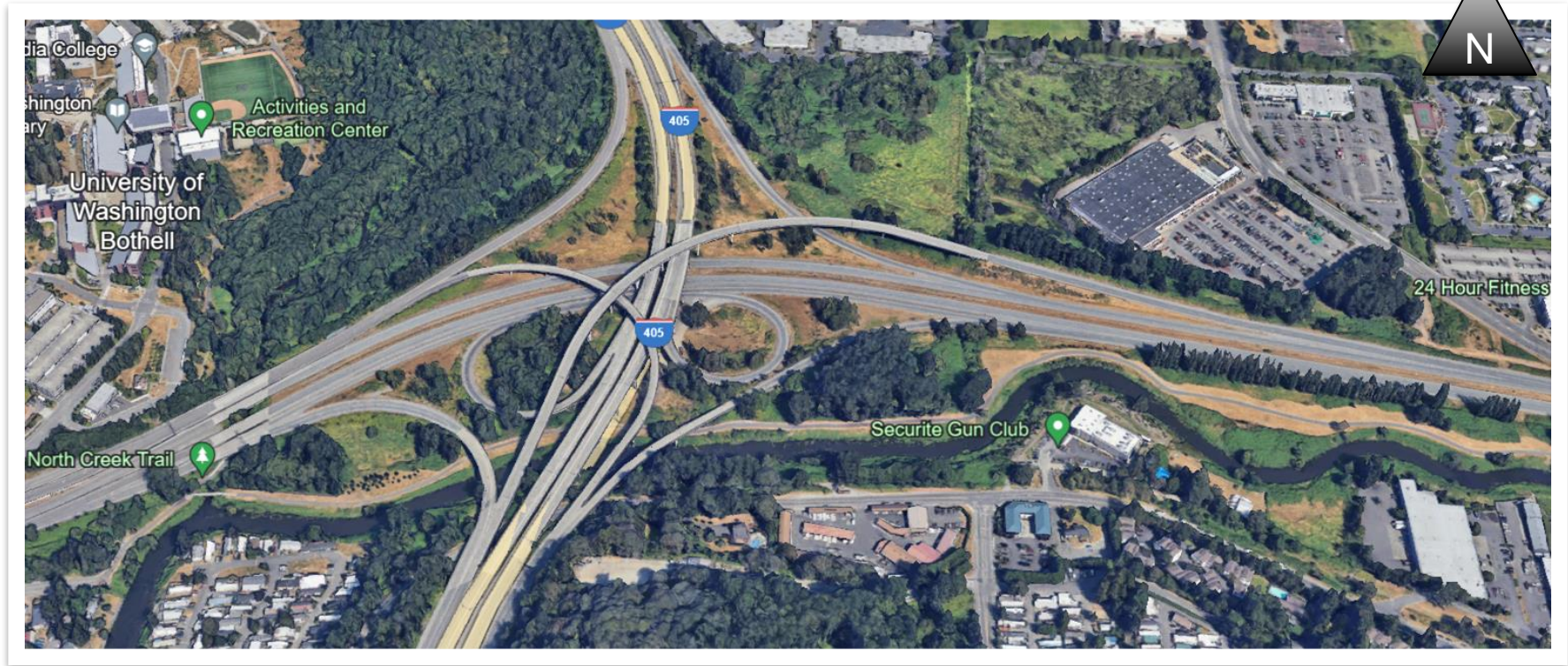
Current I-405/Brickyard Park and Ride



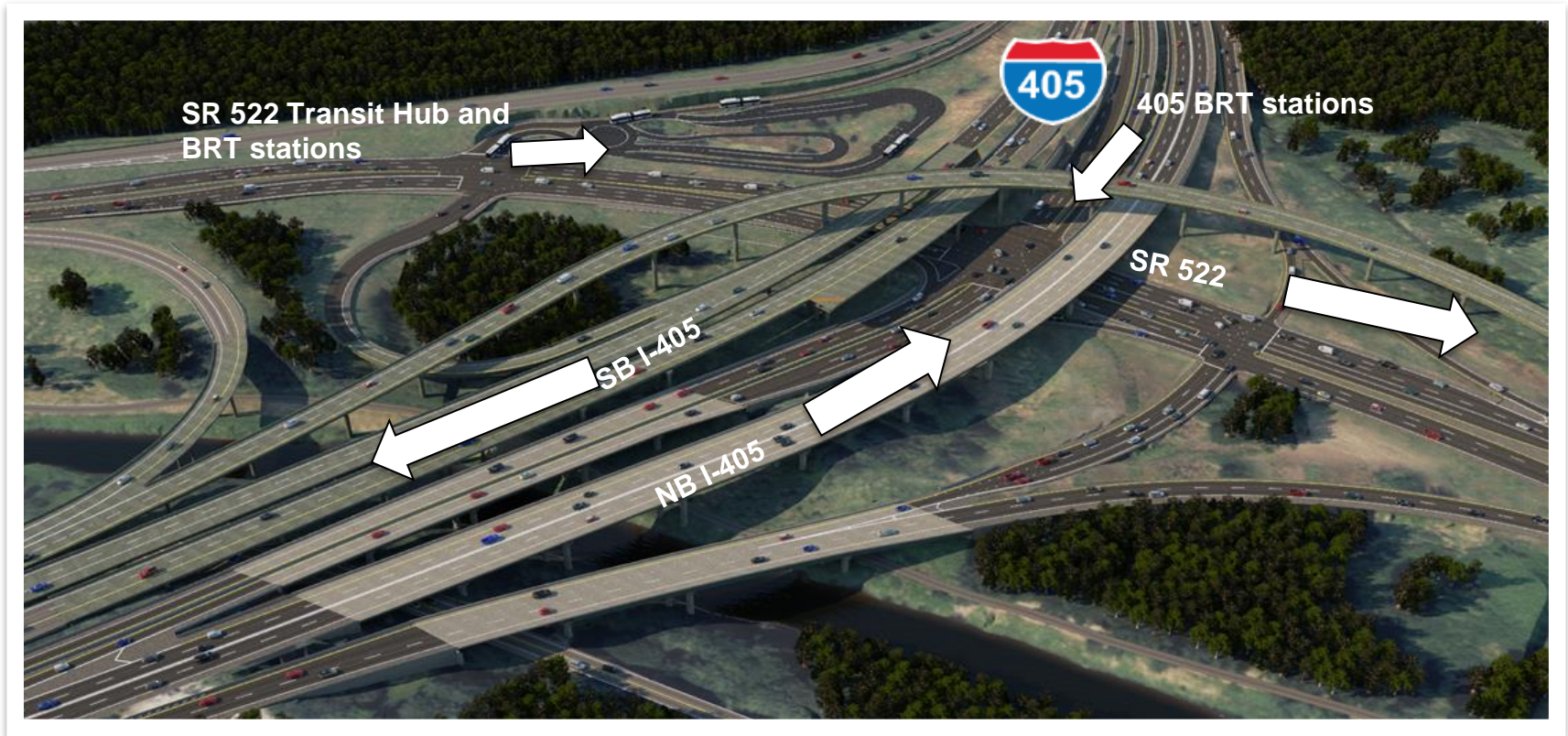
Future I-405/Brickyard Park and Ride



Current SR 522 interchange



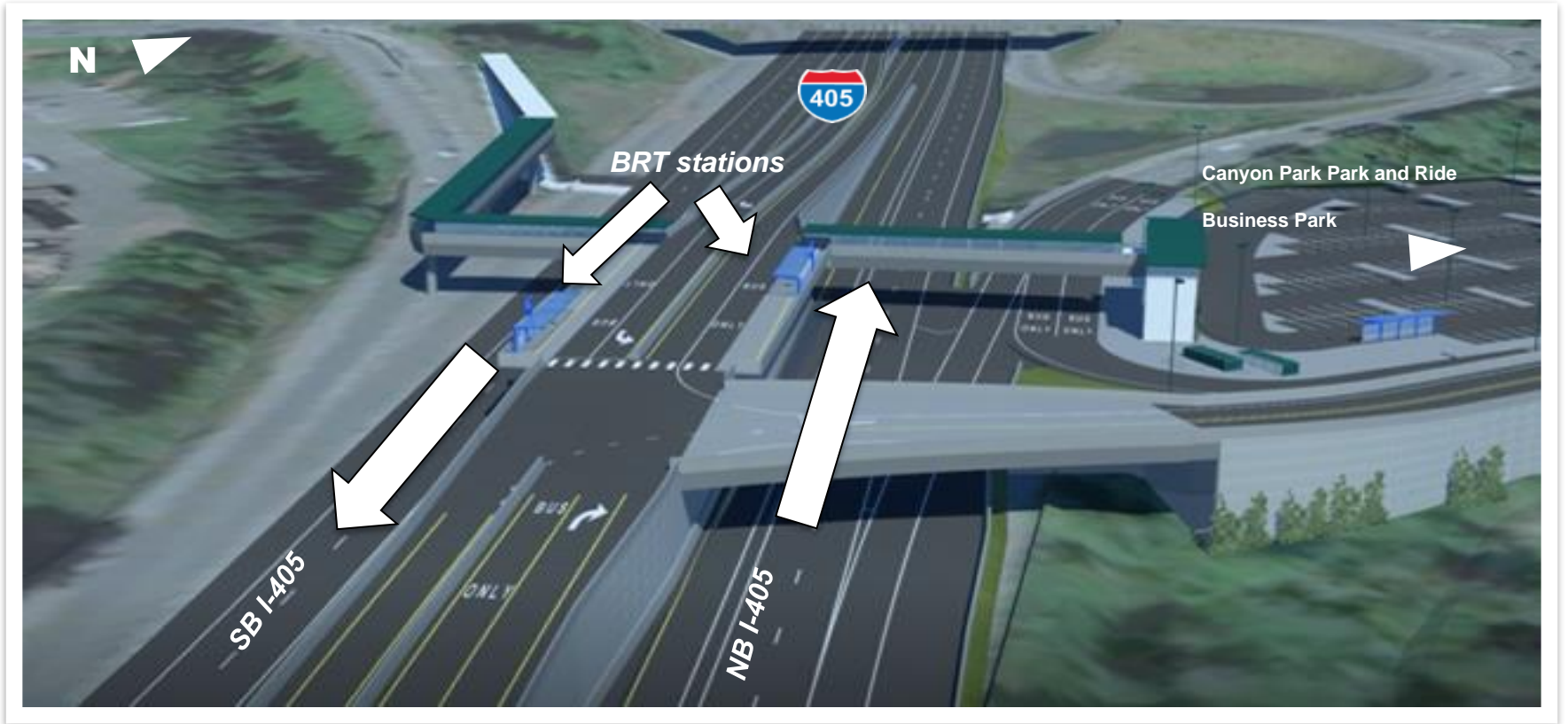
Future SR 522 interchange and hub

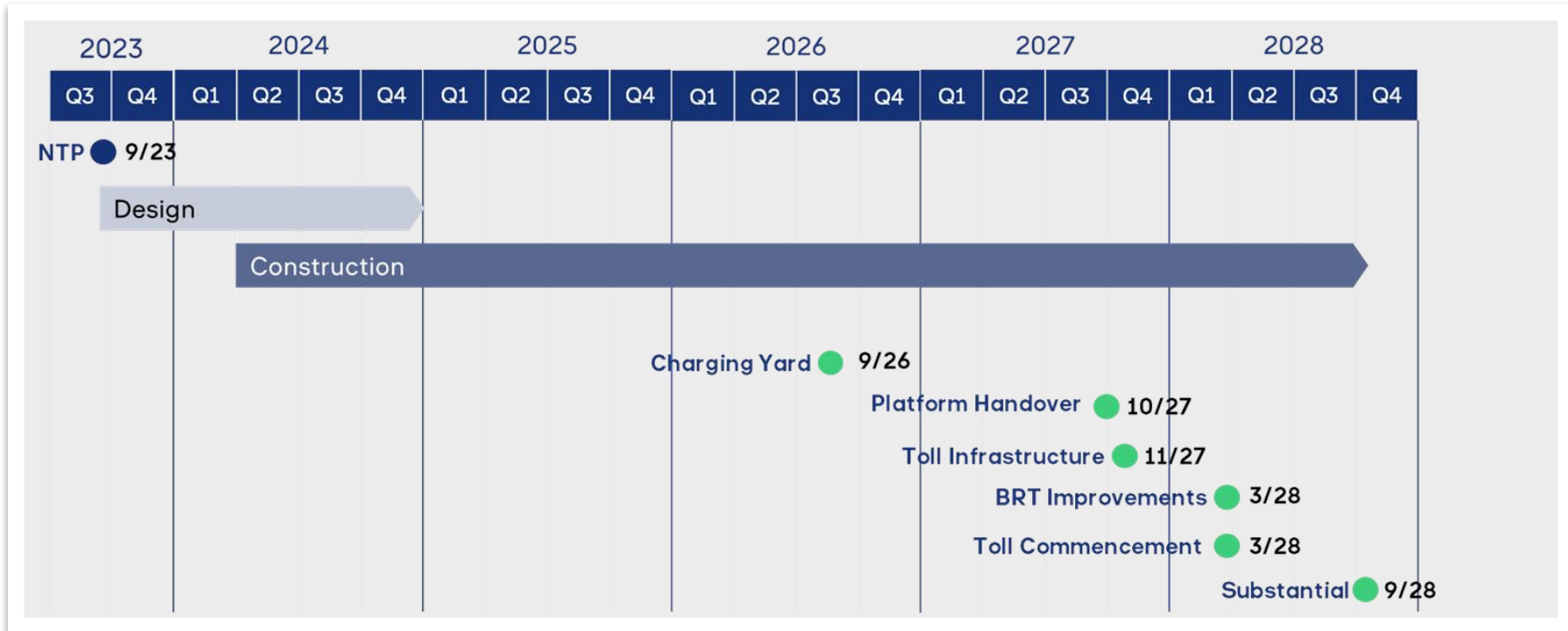

What's happened already?

- **Geotechnical surveys** and test anchors
- **Project site prep** and access work
- **SR 522 prep work** for traffic changes
- **Environmental prep work**



Crews performing saw cutting work on Woodinville Dr.

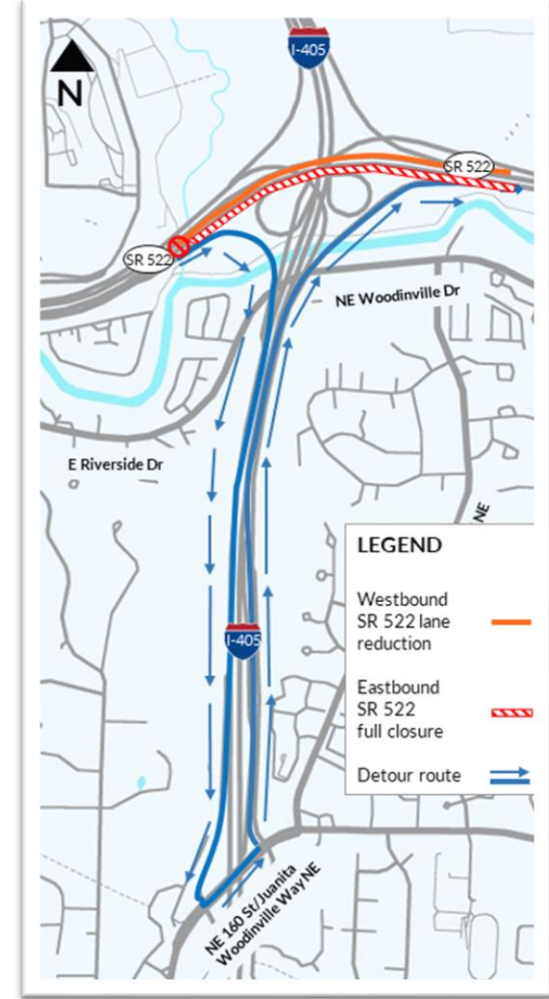
Upcoming Work

- **Ground improvements:** Building solid foundations by stabilizing the ground beneath construction areas.
- **Utility relocation:** Moving and adjusting utility pipes, cables, and lines to make way for the new infrastructure
- **Weekday and night work**



Upcoming Traffic Changes

- **Weekend lane closures:** Traffic on SR 522 reduced in both directions 4/12 - 4/15, 4/19 – 4/22
- **Lane shifts and speed limit reduction** (35 mph) starting 4/22 on SR 522
