Target Audience

This course is best suited for employees with Title VI responsibilities from cities, counties, and municipalities who are receiving federal funding from WSDOT.

Course Description

The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) will conduct Title VI training for Sub-Recipients designed to provide a comprehensive overview of Title VI statutes, to include guidance for program implementation, and administrative procedures. Upon completion of this course participants will:

- Have a general understanding of the civil rights laws and regulations that apply to Title VI;
- Be able to implement an effective Title VI Program;
- Be able to develop a Title VI Plan or a Non-Discrimination Agreement (NDA) ;
- Be able to develop yearly Title VI annual update and accomplish reports;
- Understand their responsibility in the processing of Title VI complaints;
- Understand the requirements for Limited English Proficiency (LEP) populations;
- Understand the requirements for Environmental Justice (EJ)
