

ORDINANCE NO. 806

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BREWSTER, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 12.32 OF THE BREWSTER MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO STATE HIGHWAY ACCESS STANDARDS; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 801; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Staff, Mayor and City Council have reviewed the Washington State Department of Transportation Standards for Access to State Highways that apply to areas outside of the city limits of the City and determined that these standards should be applied within the city limits of the City of Brewster, except as modified by the City Council in specific instances with respect to access widths, **now, therefore,**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BREWSTER, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 12.32 of the Brewster Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Chapter 12.32

ACCESS TO STATE HIGHWAYS WITHIN CITY LIMITS

Sections:

12.32.010 Access to State Highways.

12.32.010 Access to State Highways. The Washington State Department of Transportation Standards for Access to State Highways that apply outside of the city limits as set forth in Chapter 47.50 RCW and in Chapters 468-51 and 468-52 of the Washington Administrative Code, as the same exist now or may hereafter be amended, are hereby adopted as the City Standards for access to

portions of those state highways that are located within the city limits as the city limits exist now or may hereafter be amended; except as modified by the City Council in specific instances with respect to access widths.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 801 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after this Ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title is published.
