### Target Audience

WSDOT and Local Agency employees involved in project development (scoping), project management, roadway design, electrical design, and construction inspection.



## Course Description

This 2-day course is designed to provide WSDOT employees and Local Agency public works employees with foundational knowledge and skills to 1) evaluate existing pedestrian facilities for conformance to WSDOT guidelines and ADA requirements and 2) design and construct new pedestrian facilities that meet WSDOT guidelines and ADA requirements. This course includes classroom instruction, practical exercises, and a field review near the training facility (weather permitting). A calculator and a high-visibility reflective safety vest are required for this class.

The course has been revamped September 2011 to reinstate emphasis on background and historical information, legal implications, and the challenges faced by people with disabilities while also adding advanced material on technical requirements, a second group exercise, and more recent “lessons learned” in design and construction. The course has also been updated to be in-line with the July 2011 revision to chapter 1510 of the WSDOT Design Manual.

## Class Materials to Bring

This course includes classroom instruction, practical exercises, and a field review near the training facility (weather permitting).

Required to bring: A **calculator** and a **high-visibility reflective safety vest**
