- **Safety:** To provide for and improve the safety and security of transportation customers and the transportation system
- **Mobility:** To improve the predictable movement of goods and people throughout Washington State
- **Environment:** To enhance Washington's quality of life through transportation investments that promote energy conservation, enhance healthy communities, and protect the environment
- **Stewardship:** To continuously improve the quality, effectiveness, and efficiency of the transportation system
