Target Audience

New bridge inspectors or those who desire a complete refresher. Participants should have a general understanding of bridges. This class is equivalent to the National Highway Institute class #130055 (6 CEUs). Non-engineers and people with little or no bridge condition inspection experience are strongly advised to attend the Bridge Condition Inspection Fundamentals (BCIF) class prior to the BCIT. The Bridge Inventory Coding class is also recommended for all participants prior to BCIT.

Course Description

This course is two full weeks. This course is based on the FHWA "Bridge Inspector's Reference Manual" (BIRM) and will provide extensive training on the condition inspection of in-service bridges. Two comprehensive examinations will be administered: a field exam covering inspection and inventory coding, and a multiple choice classroom exam. Satisfactory completion of this course will fulfill the training requirements of the National Bridge Inspection Standards (NBIS) for a "comprehensive training course" based on the BIRM. This training is for new bridge inspectors or those who desire a refresher. Twenty hours in the field.

The training course will, at a minimum, cover the following topics:

1. The National Bridge Inspection Standards
2. Basic Bridge Inspection Concepts
3. Safety
4. Inspection Documentation
5. Reporting NBI Inventory Items
6. Bridge Management Systems (BMS)
7. Evaluations based on:
 - Bridge Inspector's Reference Manual (BIRM)
 - Washington State Bridge Inspection Manual
 - Inspection Reporting
 - Inventory Reporting
 - BMS Element Reporting

*Registration and Fee Schedule

This class is primarily for Washington State agencies. The following procedures apply for registration.

PRIORITY REGISTRATION: For Washington State Agencies – Free

- Consultants currently inspecting bridges in Washington State, residing in-state or out-of-state. (Consultants will be limited to five seats during priority registration, one per company.)

If you have more than one person to register, please register all of them now on-line, however only the first name on your list (as you fill out the on-line form) will be enrolled. The others will go on a wait list and will be enrolled, space permitting, after February 6, 2012, prior to those in the Open Registration group.

E-mail notifications will be sent for each person registered or wait listed, and again when those wait listed are put into the class.

OPEN REGISTRATION: For Out-of-State Attendees - \$700

Registration is open now for the **wait list**. Use the on-line registration link below to register. Individuals from the three groups here will be placed on a wait list through Monday, **February 6, 2012**.

- Agencies in other states
- Federal agencies in other states
- Consultants currently inspecting bridges in other states

After February 6, 2012, if seats are still available, names will be taken from this wait list and enrolled, in the order in which they were received. An e-mail notification will be sent when a name is moved from the wait list to the enrollee list.
