Target Audience and Course Objectives

This training is intended to provide engineering or design technicians and other personnel, who have little or no background in bridges, a basic knowledge of bridges and bridge inspection skills. This course is preparatory for Bridge Condition Inspection Training (BCIT). Graduate engineers or engineering technicians with bridge experience need not attend.

Course Description

This 3-day training is intended to provide participants with a basic knowledge of bridges and bridge inspection skills. This training will provide a basic introduction to some of the topics covered in the BCIT and will focus on introducing Bridge Mechanics, the local agency and federal bridge inspection manuals, and aspects of bridge inspection and reporting.

Participants need to bring the following:

- Local Agency Bridge Inspection Training Manual*
- FHWA Bridge Inspector's Reference Manual*
- Clipboard
- Calculator

This class is primarily for Washington State agencies. The following procedures apply for registration:

PRIORITY REGISTRATION: for Washington State Agencies – Free

Priority registration is open now to the following groups through Tuesday, **January 17, 2012**. Use the on-line registration link below to register.

- WSDOT
- Other Washington State Agencies
- Federal Agencies in Washington State
- Consultants currently inspecting bridges in Washington State (residing in-state or out-of-state)

Note to Consultants: Five spaces will be open initially to consultants during priority registration, one person per company; however, please register all those wishing to attend. The first person on your list (as you fill out the on-line form) will be registered; all other names will go on the wait list.

After **January 17, 2012**, providing there is space available, any consultants on the wait list will be moved into the class (before the out-of-state group). An e-mail notification will be sent if you are registered.

OPEN REGISTRATION: for Out-of-State Agencies - \$150

Registration is open now for the **wait list**. Individuals in these three groups will be placed on a wait list through Tuesday, **January 17, 2012**. Use the on-line registration link below to register.

- Agencies from other states
- Federal agencies in other states
- Consultants currently inspecting bridges in other states

You may register now using our on-line registration process; however, your name will be placed on the wait list and you will receive an e-mail notice to this effect. After **January 17, 2012**, provided there is space available, individuals from this group will be moved to the class. If your name is added to the class, you will receive an e-mail notification. We anticipate that everyone wanting to attend this class will be able to do so but Washington State agencies must be given first opportunity to register.
