DETAILING PROGRESS TOWARD ADOPTING REQUIRED STANDARDS:**

Please briefly describe (1) why your jurisdiction has not yet adopted the required access permitting standards for managed access state highways within city boundaries, (2) where your jurisdiction is in the process of adopting the required standards, and (3) what date you anticipate the required standards will be adopted.

The City of Richland was unaware of the requirement to formally adopt access standards for SR-224 into its municipal code. We have, however, traditionally implemented the standards set forth in Section 1435 of the WSDOT Design manual. We are currently developing an ordinance that will establish access standards consistent with the WSDOT standards for a Class 3 highway. We will present the ordinance to City Council for first reading on December 4, 2007 and anticipate adoption of the ordinance on January 8, 2008.
