

## AGREEMENT NO. GCA 5620, SUPPLEMENT NO. 1

This Supplement 1 to Agreement GCA 5620 is made and entered into between the State of Washington, Department of Transportation, hereafter the "WSDOT," and the Washington State Patrol, hereinafter the "WSP," collectively the "PARTIES" and individually the "PARTY."

WHEREAS, the PARTIES previously entered into Agreement, No. GCA 5620 on January 23, 2008, which provided for the reimbursement of costs to the WSP for the construction of a scale house facility, static scales, and inspection building as part of the WSDOT's I-90 Spokane Port-of-Entry Weigh Station Relocation Project, and

WHEREAS, it was found that in order to meet Spokane County building permit requirements a water well must be drilled before the building permit is issued, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to supplement the Agreement to provide for an increase in the Scope of Work and associated increase in the actual direct and related indirect cost of the WORK, due to the previously unknown above requirement,

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to chapter 39.34 RCW and in consideration of the terms, conditions, covenants and performances contained herein, or attached and incorporated and made a part hereof,

## IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Cost Estimate, Exhibit A, in the Agreement is hereby supplemented with the additional Cost Estimate for the water well, Exhibit A-1, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof. The maximum amount payable under the Agreement is hereby increased by THIRTY-SEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$37,615.00), the cost of putting in the water well, to ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$187,615.00).
2. The Scope of Work, Exhibit B, is supplemented with Exhibit B-1, detailing the additional work necessary to put in the water well. Exhibit B-1 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Supplement No. 1.
