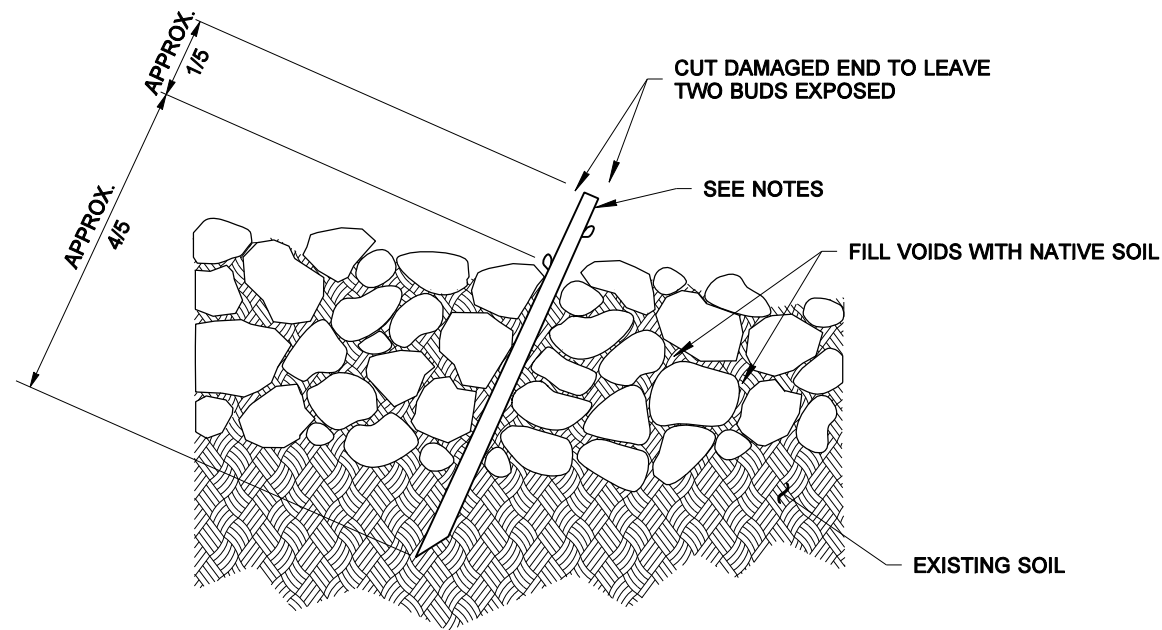
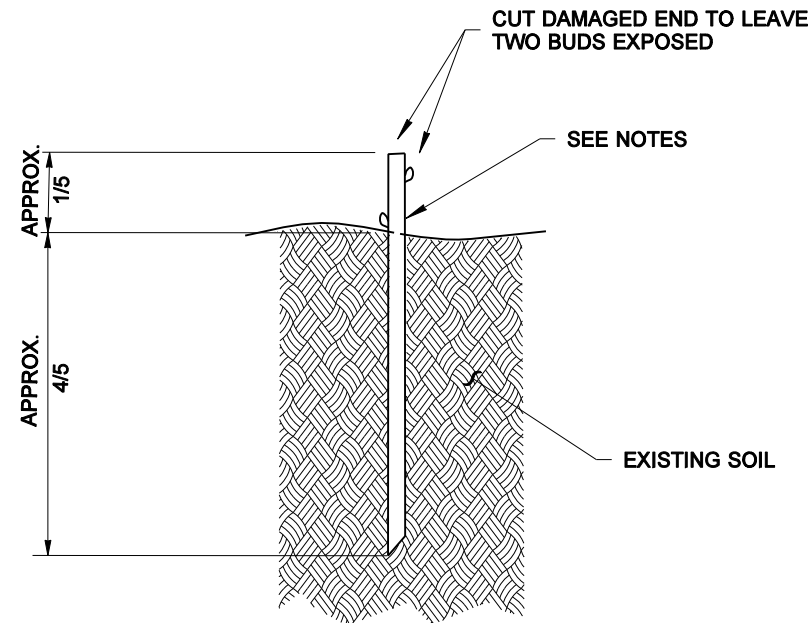

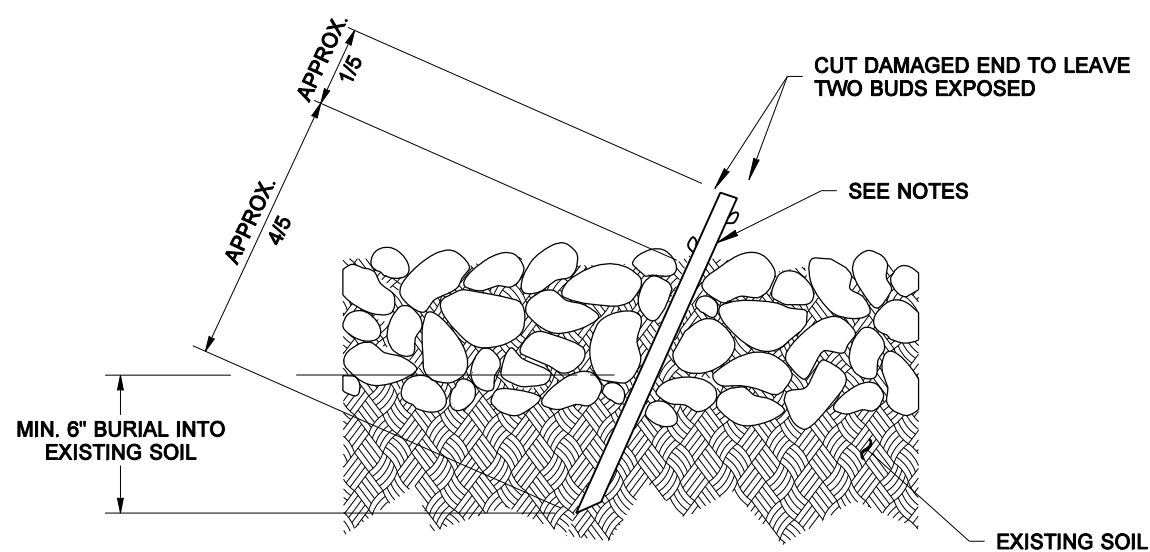
**LIVE STAKE INSTALLATION IN RIPRAP**



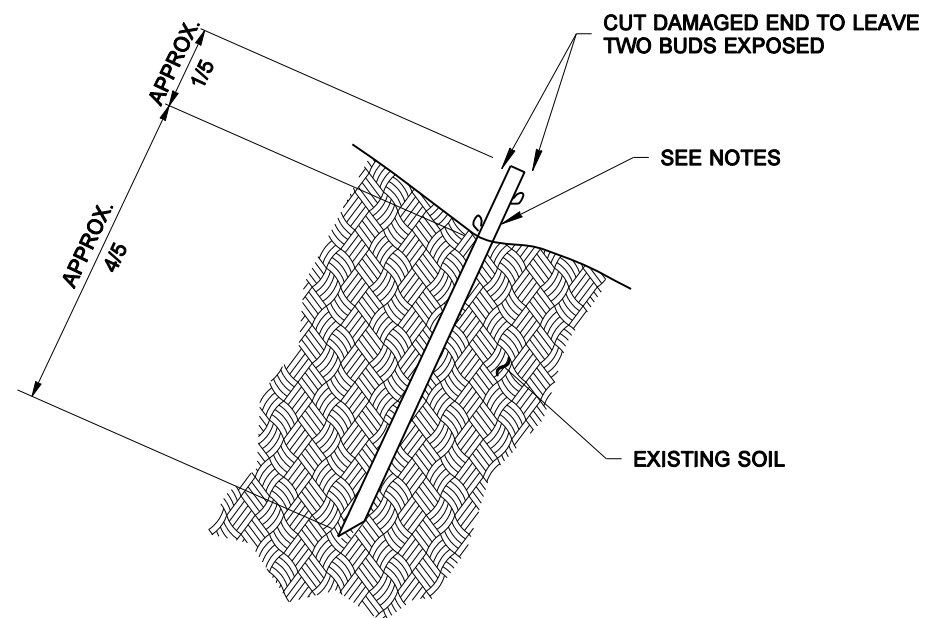
**TYPICAL LIVE STAKE INSTALLATION**

**NOTES**

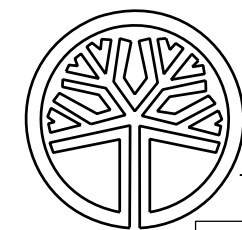
1. See Plant Material List for size and type of live stake.
2. Do not use axe or sledge for driving stakes.
3. In hard ground use an iron bar or star drill to prepare the holes for the stake.
4. Avoid stripping bark or bruising stakes during installation.
5. Fill void around cutting with soil.
