


# Daybreak School Safety Improvements

## Daybreak Primary & Middle School, Battle Ground

Grant Amount: \$184,000

February 2012



### Performance Measures and Project Report Highlights:

- There was a three percent increase in the number of children walking and biking to school;
- After the completion of the project there were 395 children that were walking or biking to school; and
- The project has led to a joint memorandum of understanding and stronger partnership between the school district and the City of Battle Ground.

### New Infrastructure

- One overhead flashing beacon
- Street lighting
- School speed zone flashing beacons
- Sidewalk improvements

**Project Description:** The project includes sidewalk, signs, overhead crosswalk flashers, and school speed zone. These infrastructure improvements, as well as the increased police patrols were implemented to provide a safer walk route for the 383 children that were already walking to school. In addition, the projects safety education element was presented to all 1,150 students that are served by the two schools.

**Infrastructure Location:** 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue between the two schools & Onsdorff Road.
