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


Construction update - July 2012

July was a busy month for the SR 520 Bridge Replacement and HOV Program. Crews floated out the first cycles of pontoons from casting basins in Tacoma July 23-26 and Aberdeen on July 30. Six pontoons were built at each location, and the pontoons will arrive on Lake Washington to support the new SR 520 floating bridge.


At the same time, construction continued in Kenmore on precast bridge elements and on the Eastside, where crews completed work throughout the month and during a July 13-16 full weekend closure.
