

Innovative Safety Program – Opens the **2016 Call for Projects**

A call for projects for the Innovative Safety Program is open, through the Washington State Department of Transportation's Local Programs division.

The purpose of the Innovative Safety Program is to reduce fatal and serious injury collisions on public roads using one or more specific engineering improvements/countermeasures. The program focuses on four specific technologies that are low cost, quick to implement, and have a good potential to reduce fatal and serious injury crashes.

Those four technologies are:

- High Friction Surface Treatments
- Intersection Conflict Warning Systems
- Projects to Increase Traffic Signal Operations or Visibility
- Compact Roundabouts
