2013-2015 Biennium

- \$3.5 million awarded
- 53 grants
- 84 projects
 - 84.51% expended
 - \$420k carryover / 14 grants
 - Re-appropriation requested FY17

2015-17 Biennium Airport Aid Program

2015 grant cycle

- Application deadline June 5
 - 52 applications
 - 55 airports
 - 77 projects
 - \$2.8 million state
 - \$41.4 million federal
 - \$3.6 million local
 - \$48 million total

2015-17 Biennium Airport Aid Program

2015 grant cycle - continued

- Awarding approximately \$2 million
 - 45 grants
 - 48 airports
 - 60 projects

2015-17 Biennium Airport Aid Program

2016 grant cycle

- Application solicitation February & March
- Grant awards mid-May
- Anticipate awarding \$2 million

This document includes form fields which are used to complete the Airport Aid Application Forms.

Saving the .pdf document to your computer should allow you to save your entries and then edit the document at a later time.

However - Depending on the Adobe Acrobat version that you are using, your work might NOT be saved. It is suggested that you make an entry, save the document, exit the document, and then re-open the document to see if your data saved.

Ensure you have completed ALL field entries.

Make sure to save your work frequently.

If you are not able to save your work you will need to print the application before closing the document.

Options for submitting your application:

By Email -
