


# Noise

## Noticeable noise at either Grays Harbor site

- Aberdeen Log Yard: Increased noise from hauling and construction activities, but noise levels are anticipated to remain within state noise ordinances.
- Anderson & Middleton: Could exceed Washington noise ordinance at nearby residences because of proximity and the lack of shielding.
  - A noise wall could reduce the noise from the Anderson & Middleton site to comply with state noise regulations.
  - In order to be effective, the noise wall would have to be 16 to 18 feet high and extend 1,200 feet along the north side of the site from 5th Street to 8th Street.

## Community coordination and outreach

- We will work with the design-build contractor to conduct regular outreach with community members and business owners to ensure that they understand the project schedule and what to expect for noise and other effects.
- We will work with the design-build contractor to ensure that project-related noise is consistent with local noise regulations.
