
Best Management Practices (BMP)

- Developed during the Airport Investment Study.
- A “Tool-Kit” to assist Airport Managers maximize local capitol revenue streams in order to increase project eligibility for Federal and State grants as well as funding those projects otherwise ineligible for grant money.
- WSDOT Aviation is taking this further by partnering with the aviation community to both optimize management best practices and business development.
