2" x 2" (IN) UNTREATED WOOD STAKES (FIR, HEMLOCK, CEDAR OR PINE), 3' (FT) IN LIVE FASCINE BUNDLE FOLLOWING SPECIES COMPOSTION AS SHOWN IN THE

STREAMBED SEDIMENT PER STANDARD

2" × 2" (IN) UNTREATED WOOD STAKES (FIR, HEMLOCK, CEDAR OR PINE), 3' (FT) IN LIVE FASCINE BUNDLE FOLLOWING SPECIES COMPOSTION AS SHOWN IN THE

NOTES:

- 1. See plant material list for species.
- 2. Live fascines shall be constructed of live and dead cuttings at 3/4" (in) diameter bundled together with an overall diameter of 8 to 18 inches. Dead cuttings shall constitute no more than 40 percent of the total fascine bundle.
- 3. The total length of each live fascine shall be a minimum of 5 feet. Branches shall be bundled into log-like forms and bound with biodegradable coir twine spaced at 1 foot intervals along the entire length of the live fascine.
- 4. Live fascines shall be installed horizontally in a trench whose depth shall be 3/4 the diameter of the live fascine. Secure the live fascine with wood stakes at 3 intervals.
- 5. The ends of live fascine bundles shall be woven together so that no gap remains between the two sections of the live fascine.
- 6. See Standard Specification Section 8-02.3(15(A), for additional requirements.
