Keen Independent Research LLC (Keen Independent) is pleased to submit our proposal in response to Washington State Department of Transportation's RFQ for the FAA 2024 Disparity Study.

### Introduction

Keen Independent is an economic consulting and policy analysis firm with a primary focus on disparity studies and design of MWDBE programs for government entities. The firm numbers 23 people, which makes us the largest dedicated disparity study consulting team in the country. Our diverse staff are located across the country and combine strong quantitative and qualitative research expertise.
