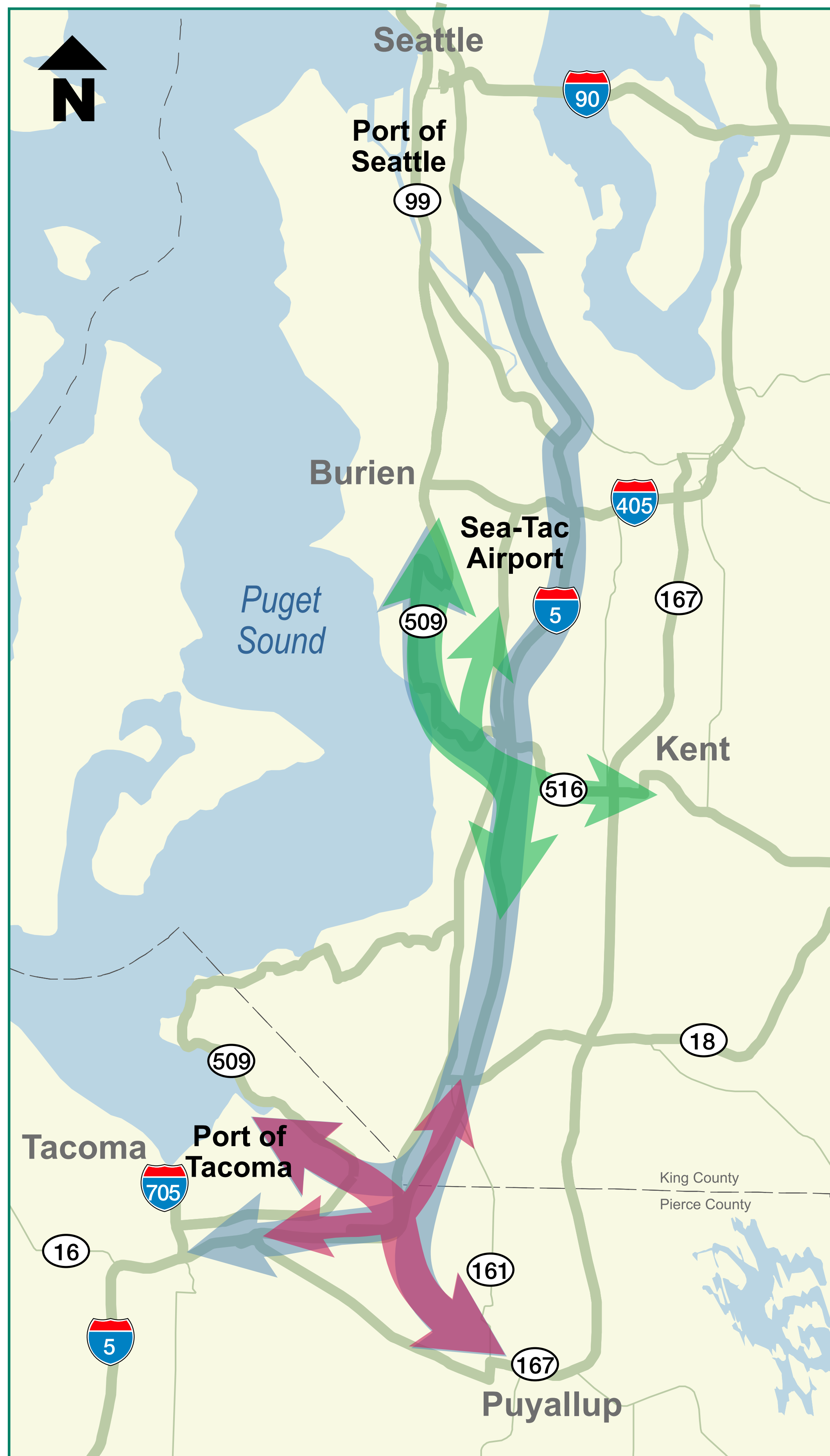
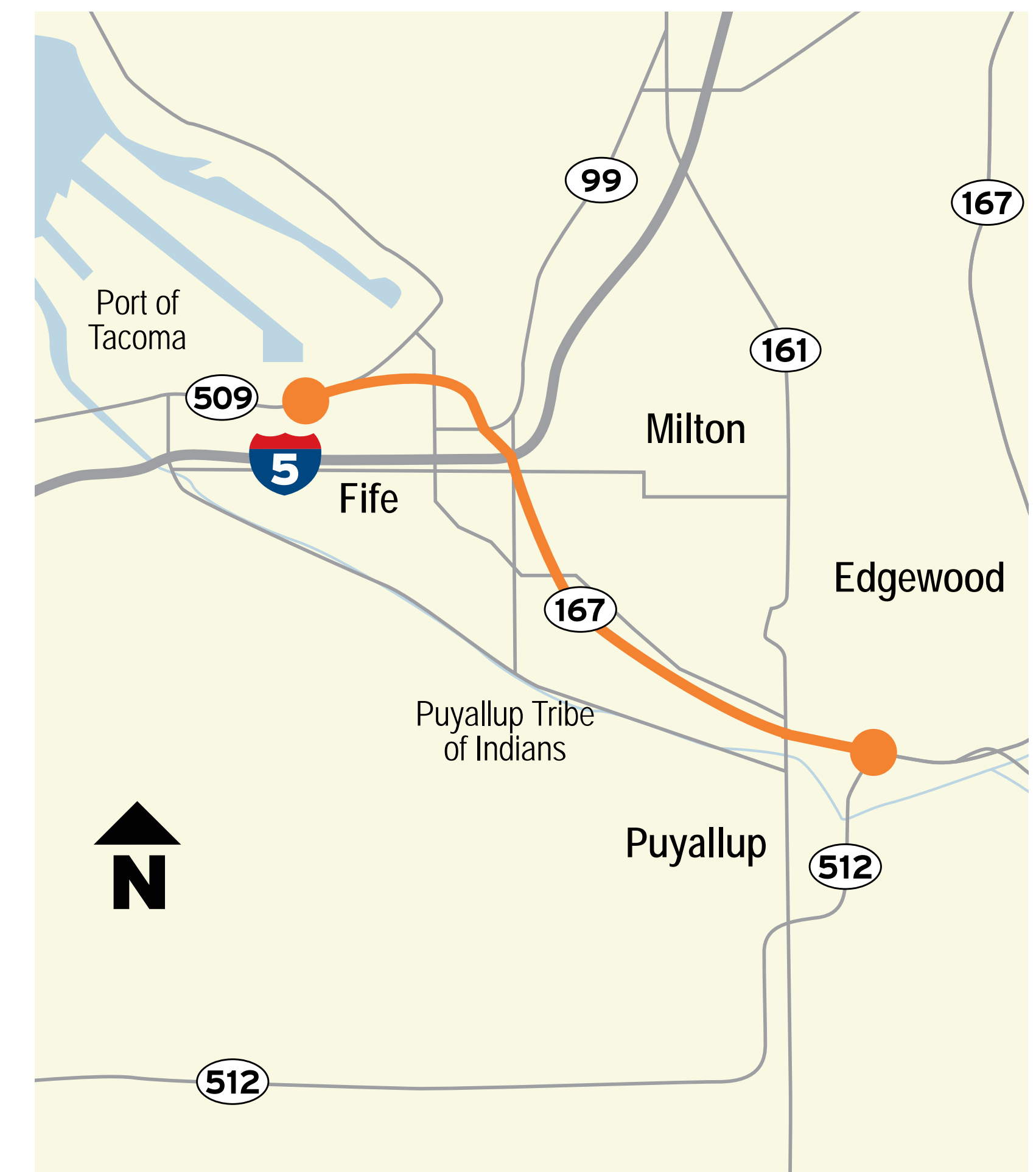
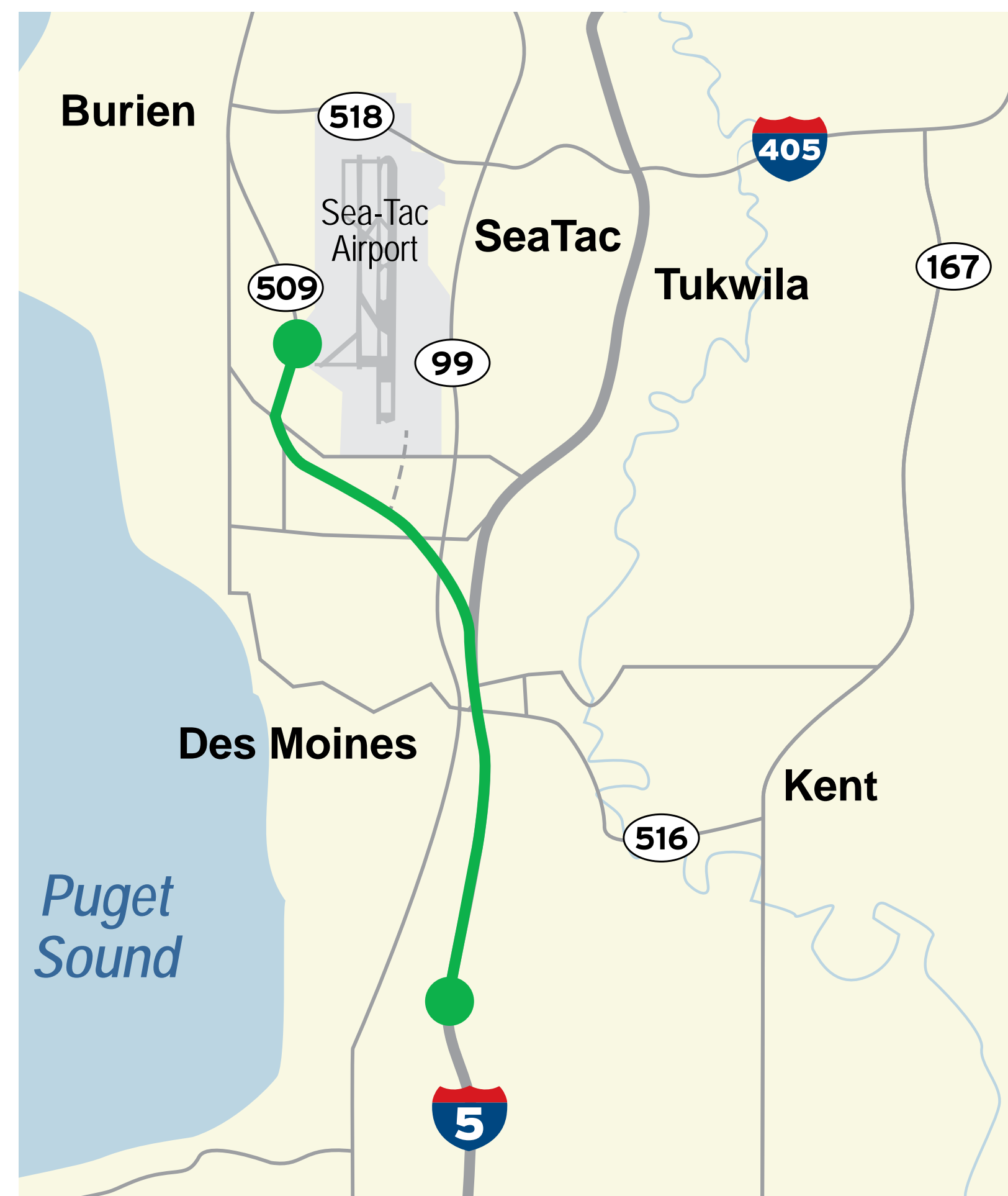


# Puget Sound Gateway Program Overview
