Entering items L.S. Est. and Calc Items

EBASE communicates the data you enter to many other agency systems.

EBASE Supports and is a crucial link in the entry of, and as a conduit for estimate Data. EBASE provides reports used in many facets for keeping the Highway Programs on Track, Determining Lowest responsible bidder for Awards, contract Payments, as well as interfacing and providing data to systems such as – CCIS, CAPS, BIDS, TRIPS and the DATAMART.

Some of these systems have specific requirements for how the information they receive is formatted.

Please remember that When Entering bid items that have a unit of measure that is:

EST, L.S., and CALC.

The "Unit Price" Is Always Entered As **\$1.00** and the total dollars for the item are entered in the "planned Quantity" field.

The only exception to this is a Pro-rated L.S. Item.
