Project Description

The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) and the City of Spokane have teamed up to develop low-cost improvements for intersections on the US 195 corridor from Hatch Road to I-90. With the number of collisions occurring at these intersections, and the increasing traffic volumes, the team is looking at options that will reduce the likelihood of future collisions while still providing acceptable access to and from US 195.

What is the purpose of the Open House?

The purpose of this Open House is to gather input from the community on the alternatives developed for Thorpe Road and 16th Avenue intersections.

The alternatives that will be displayed at the open house have been developed based on input obtained previously from the community. Your input is essential to continue moving forward with a project that meets the needs of the community within the available budget.

From the information gathered at the open house, a preferred alternative for Thorpe Road and 16th Avenue will be developed. Construction could happen as soon as 2017 for either one or both of the intersections, depending on the estimated cost of the project.
