Commuter profile #1 – typical peak commuter

Commuter profile #2 – typical peak commuter

Consider Leslie's commute schedule if she walks on vs. if she drives on.

Commuter profile #3 – special user - hazmat

He makes daily pick-up and drop-off runs to and from Vashon Island on the hazmat sailings and is often crunched for time. Consider his sailing schedule if he plans to utilize hazmat sailings.

Commuter profile #4 – special user – swing shift

Donna lives in Port Orchard and works the second shift as a project engineer at the Boeing Factory in Renton from 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Consider her commute schedule if she drives on.

Commuter profile #5 – special user - reverse commuter

Ron lives on Vashon and works at the Puget Sound Naval Shipyard as a welder. Ron works the 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. shift. Consider his commute schedule if he drives on some days and can take a vanpool occasionally.

Commuter profile #6 – special user – student commuter

Chris is a Vashon High School student who lives in Fauntleroy. Every morning, he rides the ferry along with a group of fellow students. Consider Chris' commute schedule if the morning bell is at 7:55 a.m. and the afternoon bell is at 2:45 p.m.
