SR 520/I-5 Express Lanes Connection Project construction starting soon

WSDOT expects construction to start soon on the SR 520/I-5 Express Lanes Connection Project. This project is building a new, reversible transit/HOV lane along the I-5 express lanes between SR 520 and Mercer Street, along with reversible ramps at those two I-5 interchanges.

The project will provide a faster, more reliable bus and carpool connection between the Eastside and Seattle's bustling South Lake Union neighborhood.

WSDOT recently selected Walsh Construction as the contractor for this design-bid-build project. Construction is scheduled to begin this summer. The project duration is approximately three years.
