Target Audience: This training is intended for bridge program personnel charged with maintaining correct and current National Bridge Inventory (NBI) coding for the bridges owned by their agency.

Course Description: This course is designed to provide knowledge of the requirements for the correct coding of bridges contained in the National Bridge Inventory (NBI). Participants will practice coding a bridge from bridge plans using the Washington State Bridge Inventory report (WSBIS form). Participants will also practice calculating bridge sufficiency ratings manually.
