Key Elements

Key elements of effectiveness include a partnered atmosphere with empowered project team members who are able to recognize and overcome obstacles, initiate effective public involvement, maintain effective and open communication between all stakeholders and streamline project administration where appropriate.

Eligibility

To be eligible for an award, projects must be administered by WSDOT, have the major construction activities completed, and a valid application package must be submitted on or before the deadline. Nominations received after the deadline will be kept on file until the next year for judging.

Application

To nominate a project, submit a completed application package to WSDOT. A collaborative effort between the Project Engineer and the Contractor is encouraged when assembling information to nominate a project. However, either party can initiate the process. See the instructions page for additional details.

Evaluation Criteria

Criteria for selection is divided into six categories as follows:

1. Customer-Focused Administration
2. Overcoming Extraordinary Challenge
3. Timely Project Completion
4. Innovative Problem Solving
5. Effective Contract Administration
6. Safety

Selection Process

All nominations must be received **on or before October 18, 2021**. A panel of impartial judges will review all applications, decide for each category whether an award is warranted, and if so, who should receive the award.

Awards Presentation

Winning teams for the Partnership for Excellence in Contract Administration Awards will be announced during the Annual AGC/WSDOT Joint Meeting.
