## <u>Purpose</u>

The combination of increasing delivery demand and significant turnover at the Project Engineer (PE) position are forcing Regions to consider the temporary use of consultants to fill PE vacancies. In order to maintain Federal participation on WSDOT projects WSDOT must define what work can or cannot be completed by Consultant Project Engineers (CPE).

## **Guidance**

In accordance with 23 CFR 635.105, WSDOT must have a full-time employee to be in responsible charge of each project. Accordingly, the Construction Manual outlines delegation and assignment of duties to specific agency positions, with the Project Engineer acting as WSDOT's person in responsible charge.

The duties and functions as defined by FHWA of responsible charge are as follows:

- Administers inherently governmental project activities, including those dealing with cost, time, adherence to contract requirements, construction quality and scope of Federal-aid projects;
- Maintains familiarity of day-to-day project operations, including project safety issues;
- Makes or participates in decisions about changed conditions or scope changes that require change orders or supplemental agreements;
- Visits and reviews the project on a frequency that is commensurate with the magnitude and complexity of the project;
- Reviews financial processes, transactions and documentation to ensure that safeguards are in place to minimize fraud, waste, and abuse; and
- Directs project staff, agency or consultant, to carry out project administration and contract oversight, including proper documentation.
- Is aware of the qualifications, assignments and on-the-job performance of the agency and consultant staff at all stages of the project.

The Region Construction Manager, or those delegated Region Construction Manager authority, may assign a qualified CPE, with limited authority to act on behalf of WSDOT. The State Construction Office's interpretation of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) has led to a determination that duties listed under the WSDOT heading of the attached Responsible Charge Table cannot be completed by CPE's. The Table indicates that some project engineering duties can be supported by consultant PEs, but ultimate signature authority must remain with the person in responsible charge and cannot be delegated.



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When a Region intends to use a consultant as a consultant PE the Region Construction Manager must send a Consultant Project Engineer Assignment Memo to the State Construction Engineer. This memo is required for each project that is supported by consultant PE's to identify the general scope of the consultant's duties in the PE office and the WSDOT employee who will act as the person in responsible charge. The WSDOT employee identified in the memo will perform the duties that cannot be performed by a consultant. Along with the memo, the Responsible Charge Table will be used to identify the line items that will be performed by the consultant and the responsible charge. This memo will remain in the project files.

#### **Background**

In recent years, WSDOT began hiring consultants to perform a variety of duties on WSDOT construction projects. As consultants have been hired to fill project engineer positions, questions arose from what activities they had authority to perform.

The Responsible Charge Table was created using Chapter 1 of the Construction Manual to breakdown relevant WSDOT PE duties to ensure that the requirements of the CFR are met to maintain federal funding on our projects. This breakdown of duties is based on definitions found in 23 CFR 635.105 *Supervising Agency* and the August 04, 2011, FHWA memorandum defining "Responsible Charge".
