## Searching for SBEs in the Certified Business Directory

Searching for federal Small Business Enterprise (SBE) businesses in the Certified Business Directory is now easier than ever. There are no special search instructions for SBEs, as they can all be located by performing standard searches.


### CERTIFICATIONS THAT CAN FULFILL THE FSBE GOAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Small Business Enterprises (must be certified by OMWBE)
- Disadvantaged Business Enterprises



These instructions will guide you through a standard search to locate all SBEs in the Certified Business Directory which is managed by the state Office of Minority & Women's Business Enterprises (OMWBE).

1. In the Certified Business Directory <https://omwbe.wa.gov/certified-businesses-directory>, select **“Search for Certified Businesses.”**
2. Under **Search by Certification Type** – “Small Business Enterprise (SBE)” should be the only certification type selected.
